Policy Statement:

- Contacting the school administration, Vice Principal, or Principal directly.

Investigation and Response:

Upon receiving a report of bullying, the school will initiate a prompt and thorough investigation. The investigation will include interviews with all parties involved and any witnesses. If bullying is confirmed, appropriate actions will be taken, which may include disciplinary measures, counseling, and support for the victim.













Prevention and Awareness:

Dubai Schools Nad Al Sheba is committed to preventing bullying through awareness programs and initiatives. These may include:

Regular anti-bullying assemblies and workshops. Classroom discussions on respectful behavior and empathy. Awareness campaigns throughout the school year.

Providing resources and materials to educate students, staff, and parents about bullying prevention.

Support Services:

The school will offer support services to both victims and individuals engaged in bullying behavior. These services may include counseling, peer mediation, and access to mental health resources.
